

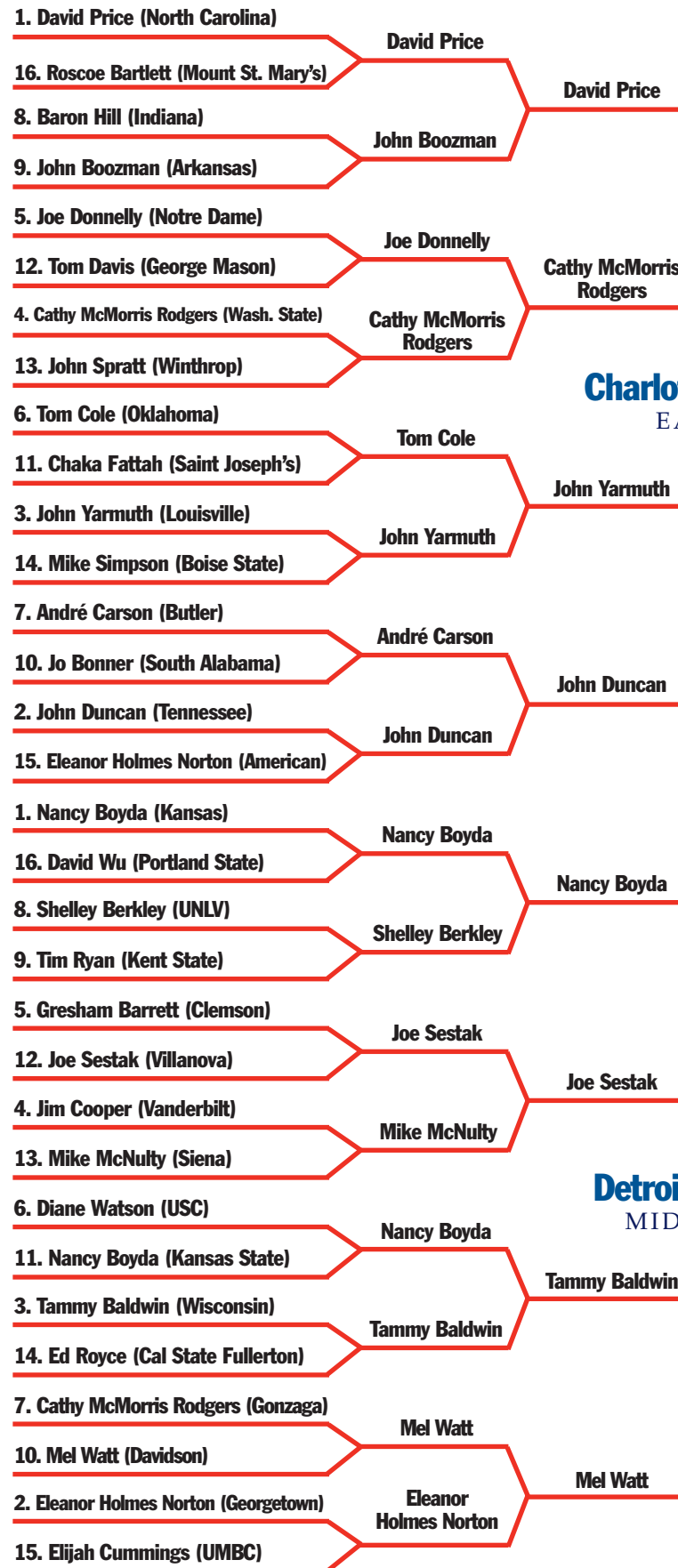
March Madness in the House

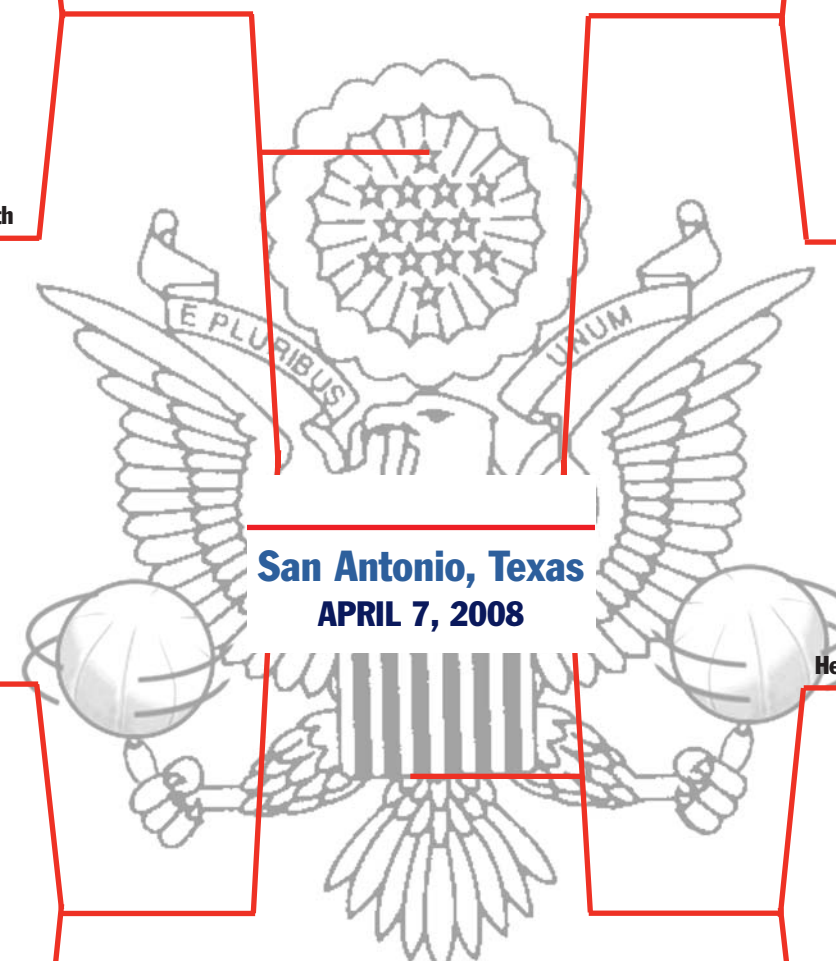

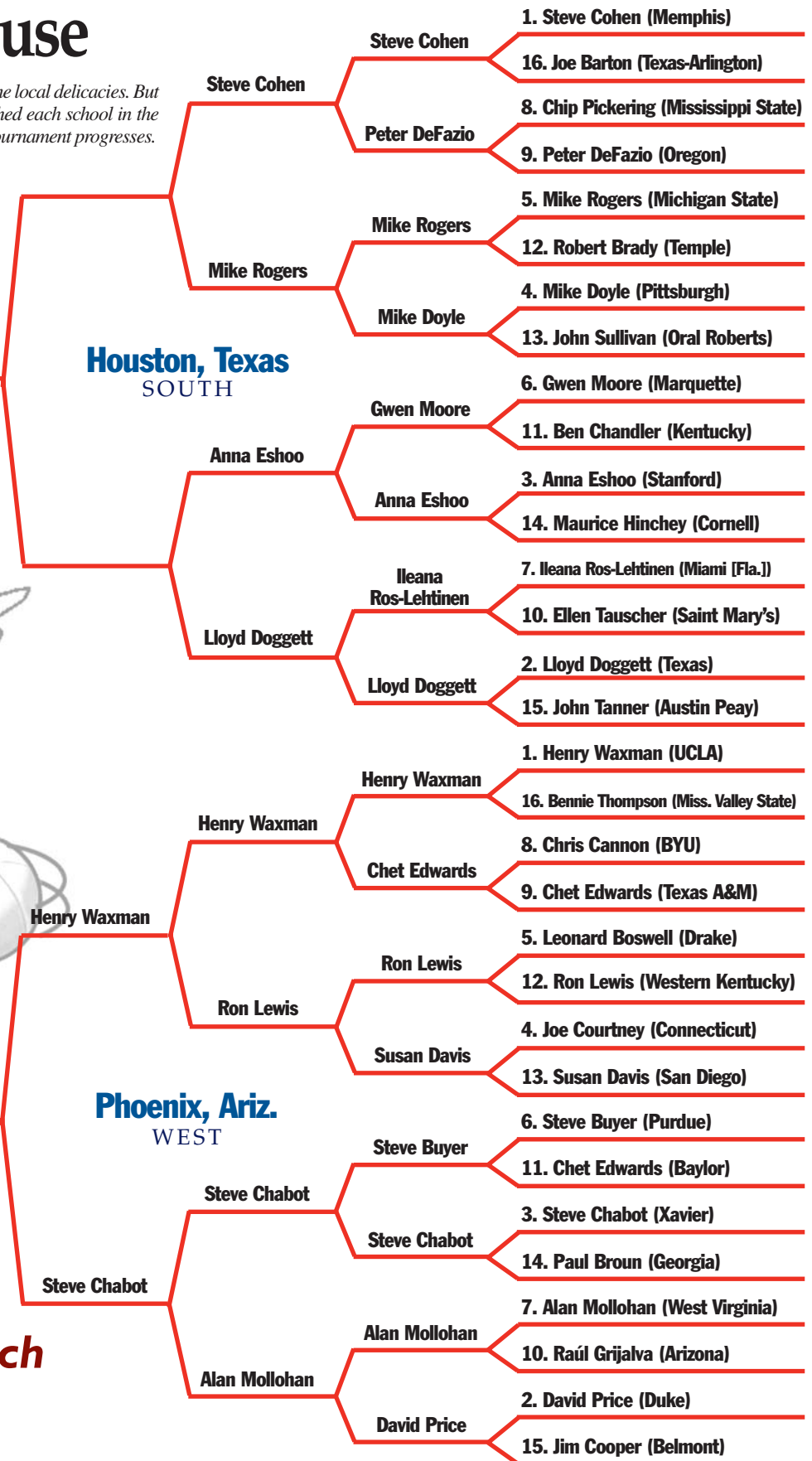
